
The law says that if you have additional needs because of a long-term health condition you are 'disabled'

(Disability Discrimination Acts, 1995/ 2005)

- This health condition can be physical or mental
- Long-term means longer than a year
- You do not need to call yourself 'disabled'

This includes people with mental health conditions, sensory impairments, physical and learning disabilities, and long-term health conditions like MS, HIV and cancer.

You have the right to be treated fairly and to have 'reasonable adjustments' made to allow you access to employment, training and services.

We welcome any feedback you would like to give about our services.

We also have a complaints policy. Mhairi can give you a copy of the full policy. If you are not satisfied then you can speak to her manager.
